

You can look no further than CloudLibrary, a fantastic digital service the North Miami Public Library offers. Here's everything you need to know to get started with CloudLibrary.

What is CloudLibrary?

CloudLibrary is a user-friendly digital platform that allows library patrons to borrow eBooks and audiobooks. With a wide range of genres and titles, CloudLibrary ensures something for everyone, whether you're into fiction, non-fiction, young adult, or children's books.

How to Use CloudLibrary

- 1. Download the App:** Start by downloading the CloudLibrary app, available for free on the App Store and Google Play Store. You can also access CloudLibrary on your computer by visiting the CloudLibrary website:

- 2. Log In:** Open the app and select your country, state, and library (North Miami Public Library). Enter your library card number and PIN to log in.
- 3. Browse and Borrow:** Once logged in, you can browse the extensive collection of eBooks and audiobooks. Use the search function to find specific titles or explore curated collections and recommendations.
- 4. Read or Listen:** After borrowing a title, you can read eBooks directly in the app or listen to audiobooks on your device. The app also allows you to adjust font sizes, bookmark pages, and track your reading progress.
- 5. Return and Renew:** Titles are automatically returned at the end of the lending period, so you never have to worry about late fees. If you need more time, you can renew your borrowings if no one else has placed a hold on the title.
