

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY ATTORNEY, IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE ATTACHED FORM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2016, the Mayor and Council of the City of North Miami (“City”) appointed Jeff Paul Henri Cazeau, Esquire, to the position of City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2016 the City and Jeff Paul Henri Cazeau, Esquire, executed an employment agreement (“Employment Agreement”) for three (3) year term; and

WHEREAS, the Employment Agreement is set to expire on April 17, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to execute an Employment Agreement with Jeff Paul Henri Cazeau, Esquire, for the position of City Attorney, in substantially the attached form.


