

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R-169

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PROPOSED BID AWARD TO GENERAL ASPHALT CO., LLC, AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER TO FURNISH MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, MACHINERY, SUPERVISION, EXPERTISE, AND SERVICES REQUIRED TO PERFORM THE C-8 CANAL PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SELECTED CONTRACTOR, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-TWO CENTS (\$3,314,515.72), IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN INVITATION FOR BID(S) NO. 35-24-25; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2025, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Invitation for Bid(s) No. 35-24-25 – Pedestrian Bridge Replacement over C-8 Canal Project* (“IFB”) requesting bids from qualified, and experienced contractors to furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and expertise needed to successfully replace the pedestrian bridge over the C-8 Canal, in accordance with the terms conditions and specifications contained in the IFB (collectively referred hereto as “Services”); and

WHEREAS, in response to the IFB, General Asphalt Co., LLC, (“Contractor”) submitted its bid and was competitively selected by City administration as the lowest-responsive, responsible bidder, with qualifications and references demonstrating to be the most advantageous to the City in the provision of Services; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of the replacement of the existing pedestrian bridge located over the South Florida Water Management District C-8 Canal; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has manifested the capability and willingness of providing Services to the City in the amount not to exceed a total amount of Three Million Three Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$3,314,515.72); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, find the execution of an agreement with the Contractor, specifically for Services designed to protect the public health, safety, and welfare, is in the City's best interest.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Award Approval.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the City Administration's competitive selection of General Asphalt Co., LLC, as the lowest-responsive, responsible contractor to furnish all the necessary labor, equipment, materials, and materials expertise needed to successfully replace the pedestrian bridge over the C-8 Canal projects.


Section 2. **Authority of City Manager and City Attorney.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement with the selected contractor, in a total amount not to exceed Three Million Three Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$3,314,515.72), in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in *Invitation for Bid(s) No. 35-24-25*.

Section 4. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
