

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SECOND OPTION TO RENEW FIREWORKS SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND PYROTECNICO FIREWORKS, INC., TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH FIREWORKS SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami (“City”) desires to retain a professional fireworks provider for the purpose of performing Independence Day fireworks display scheduled for July 4, 2019, in celebration of our nation’s Independence Day (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2017, the City issued *Invitation to Quote No. 43-16-17* (“ITQ”) seeking the provision of Fireworks Display from qualified, insured and experienced firms in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the ITQ (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, the City received two timely quotes, of which, Pyrotecnico Fireworks, Inc. (“Contractor”), was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2017, the City administration prepared a Recommendation of Award selecting Contractor as currently possessing all necessary qualifications and expertise to perform the Services; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2017, the City executed an agreement with Contractor for the provision of Services (“Agreement”) for an initial one (1) year term at a cost not to exceed thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000); and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the initial term, the City has the option to exercise two (2) options to renew the Agreement for a one (1) year term, under the same terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2018, the Mayor and City Council approved a First Option to Renew the Agreement under Resolution 2018-R-62; and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting approval to exercise the second option to renew the agreement for an additional one year term, for a total annual not-to-exceed contract amount of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that the execution of a Second Option to renew Agreement with Contractor for the provision of Services, is in the best interest of the City.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Second Option to renew fireworks services agreement, between the City of North Miami and Pyrotecnico Fireworks, Inc., to continue to provide the City with fireworks services.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.


