

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R-203

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN EXTENSION TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI AND RISK MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATES, INC., d/b/a PUBLIC RISK INSURANCE ADVISORS, A WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF BROWN & BROWN OF FLORIDA, FOR THE CONTINUATION OF POLICE PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY COVERAGE SERVICES AT AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED THREE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$306,263.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami (“City”) is desirous of required Police Professional Liability Insurance Coverage Services on behalf of eligible City employees, from a qualified, experienced, and licensed insurance provider (“Services”) as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2019, the City advertised Request for Proposal No. 57-18-19 Brokerage Firm for Public Official/Employment Practice Liability, Police Liability & Excess Workers Compensation Services (“RFP”), to procure Services in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, the City entered into an agreement with Risk Management Associates, Inc., d/b/a Public Risk Insurance Advisors (“Consultant”) for the provision of Police Professional Liability Insurance coverage in accordance with Resolution No. 2019-R-76 and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement was for one (1) year, terminating on September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the initial term, the City was allowed to exercise four (4) options to renew the Agreement on a year-by-year basis, under the same terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2020, the Mayor and City Council approved a First Option to Renew the Agreement under Resolution 2020-R-122; and

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2021, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-R-138 approving a Second Option to Renew the Agreement, and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the Mayor and City Council approved a Third Option to Renew the Agreement in accordance with Resolution No. 2022-R-138; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2023, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-R-188 approving the Fourth Option to Renew the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2024, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2024-R-136 approving an extension to the Agreement for a one (1) year period; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue Insurance Coverage Services by exercising an extension to the agreement for a one (1) year period with a policy coverage period commencing October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026, at the annualized premium amount of Three Hundred Six Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$306,263.00), including applicable agency service fees; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the execution of an agreement providing for a one (1) year extension for the continuous provision of Insurance Coverage Services as required by Florida law, is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authorization to City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an extension to the agreement with Risk Management Associates Inc. d/b/a Public Risk Insurance Advisors, a wholly owned subsidiary of Brown & Brown of Florida, for an additional one (1) year term, at a cost not to exceed Three Hundred Six Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$306,263.00) for the continuation of police professional liability coverage services.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
