

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R-202

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN EXTENSION TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BROWN & BROWN OF FLORIDA, INC., d/b/a T.R. JONES AND COMPANY FOR A ONE (1) YEAR TERM TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF EXCESS WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE SERVICES AT AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FORTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$242,539.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami ("City") is desirous of continuing the required Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance Coverage Services on behalf of eligible City officials and employees, from a qualified, experienced, and licensed insurance provider ("Services") as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2019, the City advertised Request for Proposal No. 57-18-19 Brokerage Firm for Public Official/Employment Practice Liability, Police Liability & Excess Workers Compensation Services ("RFP"), to procure Services in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFP, Brown & Brown of Florida Inc. d/b/a T.R. Jones and Company, timely submitted their Proposal and was evaluated by City administration as a high ranking responsive-responsible proposer whose Proposal, qualifications and references demonstrated to be the most advantageous to the City in the procurement of Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance Coverage Services as documented in Resolution No. 2019-R-76; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, the City Manager executed a Professional Services Agreement with Contractor for the provision of Insurance Coverage Services with a policy coverage period commencing October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020, in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in the Contract Documents ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3.2 of the Agreement, the City reserved the right to renew the Agreement for an additional four (4) successive one-year term periods, upon the completion of the initial term; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2020, the Mayor and City Council approved a First Option to Renew the Agreement under Resolution 2020-R-106; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2021, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-R-127 authorizing a Second Option to Renew the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the Mayor and City Council approved a Third Option to Renew the Agreement in accordance with Resolution No. 2022-R-136; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2023, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-R-149 approving the execution of the Fourth Option to Renew the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2024, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2024-R-135 approving an extension to the Agreement for a one (1) year term; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the execution of an agreement providing for a one (1) year extension for the continuous provision of Insurance Coverage Services as required by Florida law, is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authorization to City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an extension to the agreement with Brown & Brown of Florida, Inc. d/b/a T.R. Jones and Company, for an additional one (1) year term, at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$242,539.00) for the continuation of Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance Coverage Services.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
