

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION'S COMPETITIVE SELECTION OF SHORELINE FOUNDATION, INC., AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER TO PROVIDE THE INSTALLATION OF TREATED PILES AND WATERWAY CHANNEL MARKERS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN INVITATION FOR BID NO. 50-18-19; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SHORELINE FOUNDATION, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$64,500.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2019, the City of North Miami ("City") advertised *Invitation for Bid No. 50-18-19 – Installation of Treated Piles and Waterway Channel Markers* ("IFB"), requesting bids from qualified and experienced vendors to furnish all labor, equipment, materials and expertise needed for the installation of treated piles and waterway channel markers in Keystone Point Channel between Broad Causeway and 135th Street, east of the Intracoastal Waterway and off San Souci between Broad Causeway and Biscayne Canal, east of the Intracoastal Waterway ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, the City received three (3) bids in response to the solicitation with the two (2) lowest bidders (Lambert Bros., Inc. & Shoreline Foundation, Inc.) submitting bids in the amount of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City requested the two (2) lowest bidders to submit Best and Final Offers (BAFO) to determine the lowest bidders; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the BAFO results, Shoreline Foundation, Inc. (Contractor) was evaluated by City administration as the lowest-responsive and responsible bidder whose BAFO of Sixty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$64,500.00), qualifications and references demonstrated to be the most advantageous to the City in the procurement of the provision of Services: and

WHEREAS, Contractor has manifested the capability and willingness of completing Services within one hundred twenty (120) days from the City’s issuance of a Notice to Proceed, at a cost not to exceed Sixty Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$64,500.00); and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the selection of Contractor, and further authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for Services at a cost not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$64,500.00); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Approving Selection of Contractor. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the City Administration’s competitive selection of Shoreline Foundation, Inc., as the lowest-responsive and responsible bidder to provide all labor, equipment, materials, services and expertise required to complete the provision of Services, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the *Invitation for Bids No. 50-18-19 – Installation of Treated Piles and Waterway Channel.*

Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services with the Shoreline Foundation, Inc., at a cost not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$64,500.00).

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
