

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SECOND OPTION TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT PIGGYBACKING THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES CONTRACT NO. DMS – 10/11-008C AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION CONTRACT NO. GS-35F-0119P WITH VERIZON WIRELESS PERSONAL COMMUNICATIONS LP, TO PROVIDE THE NORTH MIAMI POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH WIRELESS VOICE AND DATA COMMUNICATION SERVICES FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO VERIZON WIRELESS PERSONAL COMMUNICATIONS LP FOR THE WIRELESS SERVICES AT AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$114,500.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2016, the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami (“City”), passed and adopted Resolution No. 2016-R-4, authorizing the emergency procurement of wireless voice and data communication services including air cards for mobile crime reporting software (collectively referred to herein as “Wireless Services”) from Verizon Wireless Personal Communications LP (“Verizon”), in accordance with Section 7-144, City Code; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of Wireless Services was accomplished by piggybacking the *State of Florida Department of Management Services Contract #DMS – 10/11-008C* and the *Federal Government General Services Administration Contract No. GS-35F-0119P* (“State Contract”), in accordance with Section 7-167, City Code; and

WHEREAS, the provision of Wireless Services to the City under the State Contract was for a term of one (1) year, commencing December 10, 2015 through December 9, 2016, with two (2) one-year options to renew; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2016, a First Option to renew wireless services for the time period of December 10, 2016 to December 9, 2017 was authorized under Resolution No. 2016-R-129; and

WHEREAS, Wireless Services are crucial to the daily function of administrative and law enforcement personnel of the North Miami Police Department, and a key element in preserving the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, to avoid the detrimental impacts resulting from an interruption of Wireless Services, City administration respectfully requests the renewal of Wireless Services from Verizon for one (1) additional year under the State Contract, commencing December 10, 2017 through December 9, 2018 (“Second Option”); and

WHEREAS, Verizon is willing to deliver Wireless Services to the City at the same favorable terms and rates provided under the State Contract; and

WHEREAS, the cost of Wireless Services for the Second Option shall not exceed the annual amount of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$114,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the provision of Wireless Services required by the North Miami Police Department in daily operations, serves the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Approval of Second Option.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the second option to renew an agreement piggybacking the *State of Florida Department of Management Services Contract No. DMS – 10/11-008C* and the *Federal Government General Services Administration Contract No. GS-35F-0119P* with Verizon Wireless Personal Communications LP, to provide the North Miami Police Department with wireless voice and data communication services for a term of one (1) year.

Section 2. **Authority of City Manager.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Verizon Wireless Personal Communications LP for the wireless services at an annual amount not to exceed One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$114,500.00).

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
