

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SELECTION OF METRO EXPRESS, INC., AS THE LOWEST, RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE CONTRACTOR TO PERFORM THE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT ON N.W. 130 STREET FROM N.W. 10TH AVENUE TO N.W. 12TH AVENUE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN INVITATION FOR BID NO. 10-17-18 – ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT – N.W. 130TH STREET; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH METRO EXPRESS, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$631,500.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2017, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Invitation for Bid No. 10-17-18 – Roadway Improvements Project – N.W. 130th Street* (“IFB”), soliciting qualifications from experienced and qualified contractors to perform a roadway improvements project along N.W. 130 Street between N.W. 10th Avenue and N.W. 12th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the IFB, the selected contractor is required to provide all necessary labor, equipment, materials and expertise required for the implementation and completion of the roadway improvements project including, but not limited to: milling and resurfacing on N.W. 130 Street from N.W. 10th Avenue to N.W. 12th Avenue, addition of curbs, gutters and on-street parking as well as installation of new drainage structures consisting of exfiltration trench, trench drain and catch basins and upgrade of existing streetlights (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, in response to the IFB, the City received and opened eleven (11) bids and Metro Express, Inc. (“Contractor”), was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, with qualifications and references demonstrating to be the most advantageous to the City in the provision of Services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City administration’s ranking, the City Manager respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the selection of the Contractor, as

the lowest, responsive-responsible bidder in the provision of Services, and authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement at a cost not to exceed Six Hundred thirty-One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$631,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the City’s best interest to approve the selection of Contractor and hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services to perform the roadway improvements project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Selection Approval. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the City administration’s ranking and selection of Metro Express, Inc. as the lowest, responsive and responsible contractor to perform the roadway improvements project on N.W. 130 Street between N.W. 10th Avenue and N.W. 12th Avenue, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in *IFB No. 10-17-18 – Roadway Improvements Project – N.W. 130th Street.*


Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an agreement for the provision of Services with Metro Express, Inc., at a cost not to exceed Six Hundred thirty-One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$631,500.00).

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
