

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-6**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA,  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN  
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
NORTH MIAMI AND THE MIAMI-DADE STATE  
ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR THE EXCHANGE OF  
CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION AND DIGITAL  
EVIDENCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND  
ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Miami ("City"), through its police department ("NMPD"), maintains Criminal Justice Information and digital evidence necessary for the administration of criminal justice functions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office ("Miami-Dade SAO") is a criminal justice agency that requires routine access to Criminal Justice Information and digital evidence to support criminal investigations and prosecutions; and

**WHEREAS**, the NMPD and Miami-Dade SAO are recognized criminal justice agencies under federal and state law and are authorized to enter into an interagency agreement for the lawful exchange of Criminal Justice Information in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations, and security policies; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed interagency agreement establishes the terms and conditions governing the secure transmission, use, safeguarding, and disposition of Criminal Justice Information and digital evidence, including compliance with applicable CJIS security requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Miami-Dade SAO desire to enter into an Interagency Agreement to allow the secure exchange of Criminal Justice Information and digital evidence through approved systems, including the A-Form Management System and EVIDENCE.COM, at no cost to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Miami recognizes that timely and secure exchange of accurate Criminal Justice Information is essential for ensuring public safety, enhancing

investigative efficiency, supporting officer safety, and enabling compliance with state and federal mandates; and

**WHEREAS**, authorizing the execution of the Interagency Agreement with Miami-Dade SAO will enhance the City's ability to administer criminal justice services through secure information sharing in accordance with applicable security protocols and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council find it in the best interest of the City and its residents to enter into an Interagency Agreement with Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office to promote efficient criminal justice administration, information security, and intergovernmental cooperation.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.**     **Approval of Agreement.** The Mayor and City Council hereby approve the Interagency Agreement between the City of North Miami and the Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office for Criminal Justice Information Exchange and Computer Usage.


**Section 2.**     **Authority of City Manager.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Interagency Agreement, in substantially the attached form, between the City of North Miami and Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office.

**Section 3.**     **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
