

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-13

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A
PURCHASE ORDER TO CUSTOM TRUCK ONE SOURCE
FOR THE PURCHASE OF A TEREX INTERNATIONAL
BUCKET TRUCK, AT AN APPROXIMATE AGGREGATE
COST NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$180,000.00), UTILIZING THE
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROVISION PURSUANT
TO SEC. 7-169 OF THE CITY CODE, ON A CONTRACT
AWARDED THROUGH THE SOURCEWELL NATIONAL
PURCHASING COOPERATIVE PROGRAM, UNDER
CONTRACT NUMBER 110421-TER; DECLARING THE
EXISTING VEHICLE AS SURPLUS; AND PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami (“City”) Public Works Department’s existing bucket truck was purchased in 2003, has exceeded its expected useful life, and has been in and out of the repair shop several times over the last twenty-four (24) months for problems with the boom; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 7-145 of the North Miami Code of Ordinances, the Procurement Director recommends that the existing bucket truck be declared surplus and be replaced with a new 2025 International MV607 Terex bucket truck; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a national purchasing cooperative which offers opportunities for member agencies to procure quality products/equipment and services as needed; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell issued *Request For Proposals No. 110421 for Goods and Services*, proposers may include aerial devices, bucket trucks, technician services and various other related equipment; and

WHEREAS, as a result of these competitive solicitations, Terex Utilities, Inc. was selected as part of a pool of vendors that manufactures the necessary equipment; and

WHEREAS, Custom Truck One Source (“Vendor”) is an authorized dealer for Terex vehicles and equipment in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-169 of the City Code authorizes the City to participate in cooperative purchasing agreements for the procurement of supplies or services with one (1) or more public entities; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 7-169 of the City Code, the City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to issue purchase orders to Vendor for the provision of an International MV607 Terex bucket truck in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000.00), based on Sourcewell Contract No. 110421-TER; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the purchase of the bucket truck at a substantial savings, in accordance with the Solicitation, is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Declaration of Surplus. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby declare the following vehicle as surplus in accordance with Section 7-145 of the Code of Ordinances: One (1) International 4400 bucket truck.

Section 2. Authority of the City Manager. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Custom Truck One Source, at an aggregate cost not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000.00), utilizing the cooperative purchasing provision pursuant to Sec. 7-169 of the City Code, for the purchase of a Freightliner Bucket Truck, based on cooperative purchasing Contract No. 110421-TER, issued through the Sourcewell national purchasing cooperative program.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
