

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018 – R - 63**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SELECTION OF CONTRACTORS, FOR THE REMOVAL, HAULING AND DISPOSAL OF DEBRIS RESULTING FROM A DECLARED EMERGENCY EVENT, ON AN AS-NEEDED, WHEN-NEEDED BASIS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS #15-17-18 - DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL SERVICES; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE SELECTED CONTRACTORS FOR THE PROVISION OF THE STATED SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2018, the City of North Miami (“City”) advertised *Request for Qualifications #15-17-18 - Disaster Debris Removal and Disposal Services* (“RFQ”), seeking a pool of qualified contractors to provide the City with the necessary labor, supervision, materials, equipment, tools, vehicles, expertise and services necessary to remove, haul and dispose of debris resulting from a declared emergency event, on an as-needed, when-needed basis (“Services”); and

**WHEREAS**, CERES Environmental Services, Inc., D&J Enterprises, Inc., CrowderGulf Joint Venture, DRC Emergency Services, LLC, and Wood Resource Recovery, LLC (collectively referred to as “Contractors”), were evaluated by City’s evaluation committee to be the top five (5) ranked Contractors to be placed on a pre-qualified list of contractors to be utilized for future spot market purchases on an as-needed basis in accordance with the procedures detailed in the RFQ; and

**WHEREAS**, all five (5) Contractors have expressed their capabilities, expertise and willingness to perform the Services for an initial three (3) year term with two (2) options to renew for an additional one (1) year period, pursuant to the terms, conditions, requirements and specifications contained in the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the City's best interests to approve the selection of Contractors, and to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with each Contractor for the stated Services.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1. Approval of Selection.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the selection of CERES Environmental Services, Inc., D&J Enterprises, Inc., CrowderGulf Joint Venture, DRC Emergency Services, LLC, and Wood Resource Recovery, LLC, for the removal, hauling and disposal of debris resulting from a declared emergency event, on an as-needed, when-needed basis, in accordance with the City of North Miami Request for Qualifications #15-17-18 Disaster Debris Removal and Disposal Services.

**Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney.** The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and the City Attorney to negotiate and execute agreements with the five (5) selected Contractors for the provision of the stated Services.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
