

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION'S COMPETITIVE SELECTION OF FLORIDA ENGINEERING & DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, AS THE LOWEST-RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER TO PROVIDE ALL LABOR, EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, SERVICES AND EXPERTISE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE N.E. 143 STREET WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS CONTAINED IN INVITATION FOR BID NO. 23-17-18; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO FINALIZE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA ENGINEERING & DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$833,885.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, the City of North Miami ("City") advertised *Invitation for Bid No. 23-17-18 - NE 143rd Street Water Main Improvements Project* ("IFB"), as amended, seeking competitive bids from qualified, licensed and insured contractors to provide all labor, equipment, materials, services and expertise required to complete improvements to the water main along Northeast 143rd Street, from Northeast 16th Avenue to Northeast 18th Avenue and along Northeast 18th Avenue from Northeast 143rd Street to Northeast 149th Street (collectively referred to herein as "Services"), in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in the IFB; and

WHEREAS, a total of thirteen (13) bids were received in response to the IFB, from which Florida Engineering & Development Corporation ("Contractor") was found by City administration to meet the experience and qualification requirement under the IFB, and was therefore ranked as the lowest-responsive and responsible bidder for the provision of Services

WHEREAS, Contractor has manifested the capability and willingness of completing Services within two hundred ten (210) days from the City's issuance of a Notice to Proceed, at a cost not to exceed Eight Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$833,885.00); and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council approve the selection of Contractor, and authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to finalize and execute an agreement for Services; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the selection of Contractor to be in the best interest of the City, and that the expeditious provision of Services are designed to protect the health, safety, and welfare of City residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Approving Selection of Contractor. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby approve the City Administration's competitive selection of Florida Engineering & Development Corporation, as the lowest-responsive and responsible bidder to provide all labor, equipment, materials, services and expertise required to complete the 143rd Street Water Main Improvements Project, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the *Invitation for Bid No. 23-17-18 - NE 143rd Street Water Main Improvements Project.*

Section 2. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to finalize and execute an agreement with Florida Engineering & Development Corporation, for the provision of services in the amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$833,885.00).

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
