

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-120

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC., AS THE SOLE SOURCE MANUFACTURER OF TYLER SOFTWARE SYSTEMS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 7-143 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO PROVIDE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT SERVICES FOR ITS COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH (CAD), MOBILE REPORTING, AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$535,142.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2008, the City of North Miami (“City”) issued *Request for Proposal No. 14-07-08, Police CAD and RMS Software Qualifications (RFP)* for the purchase of a Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS) Software Program as required by the City’s Police Department to conduct their daily operations, specifically to receive, process and dispatch law enforcement services quickly and efficiently, while providing crime statistic reports in a format required by state and federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, in response to this Solicitation, the Selection Committee determined New World Systems Corporation to be the highest ranked vendor whose proposal, qualifications and references demonstrated to be the most advantageous to the City; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2014, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-R-77, thereby effectuating a continuing Software Maintenance Agreement with New World Systems for a period of five (5) years from October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2015, Tyler Technologies and New World Systems Corporation merged, with Tyler Technologies as the surviving entity; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City enter into an Agreement with Tyler Technologies for continued maintenance and support services with an initial term commencing October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies, Inc., is the sole manufacturer and supplier of the Tyler Technologies Software System, fully compatible with the Police Department's existing equipment, accessories, and parts; and

WHEREAS, City administration respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the sole source procurement of software maintenance and support services from Tyler Technologies, Inc., at a cost not to exceed Five Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand One Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$535,142.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Authority of City Manager and City Attorney. The Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami, Florida, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and execute an Agreement with Tyler Technologies, Inc., as the sole source manufacturer of the Tyler Technologies Software System, in accordance with Section 7-143 of the City Code of Ordinances, at a cost not exceed Five Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand One Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$535,142.00).

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
