

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE COMMUNITY RELATIONS BOARD BY ADDING FOUR ADDITIONAL MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, on September 8, 1998 the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Miami re-established a Community Relations Board (C.R.B.) in the City of North Miami; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to expand the membership of the Board with the addition of four (4) members to the C.R.B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Resolution No. 98-45 is amended as follows:

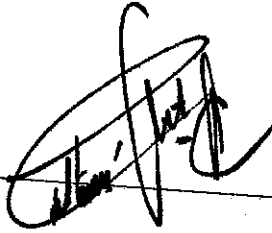
Membership; qualifications; terms. The Board shall consist of ~~nine (9)~~ thirteen (13) members, with the Mayor and City Council to each appoint one member and with ~~four (4)~~ eight (8) members to be appointed by the entire Mayor and City Council. The membership of the Board shall be representative of the various social, racial, religious, linguistic, cultural, and economic groups comprising the population of the City. Each member shall be a resident of North Miami, with an outstanding reputation for community pride, interest, integrity, responsibility, and business or professional ability. Members shall be appointed for terms of two (2) years. Any member who for any reason misses either two consecutive meetings or a total of three meetings shall automatically cease being a member of the Board. Any member may also be removed by a three-fifths vote of the City Council. In filling any vacancy, the City Council shall select the replacement Board member from a list of ~~three (3)~~ candidates to be submitted by the remaining members of the Board. Members shall ~~receive compensation of \$10 per meeting, and shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in official duties, as may be determined and approved by the City Council.~~

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage by the City Council.
