

ORDINANCE NO. 720

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A YOUTH OPPORTUNITY BOARD, PRESCRIBING THE QUALIFICATIONS, TENURE AND APPOINTMENT THE MEMBERS THEREOF, PRESCRIBING THE POWERS, DUTIES AND PROCEDURE OF SAID BOARD, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Establishment of Youth Opportunity Board. Composition and Qualifications.

(a) There is hereby created and established the Youth Opportunity Board consisting of eleven (11) members who shall be appointed by the City Council and shall hold office at the pleasure of the City Council.

(b) Each member shall be a resident of the City and shall neither hold, nor be a candidate for any other public office or position within the City of North Miami during the term of such appointment or for a period of six (6) months after termination or resignation and any member who ceases to reside within the City limits during his term of office shall be deemed to have resigned as of the date of his removal from the City. The City Council shall appoint a qualified person to serve out the unexpired term of any member vacating office by resignation or otherwise.

Section 2. Term of Office, Quorum, Officers, Removal.

(a) The City Council shall appoint eleven (11) members of the Youth Opportunity Board to hold office until the second Tuesday in June of the odd numbered year next following their appointment. Appointments thereafter shall be until the second Tuesday in June of successive odd numbered years. In every instance members shall hold office until a successor is duly appointed and all terms of office shall begin and end at noon on the date indicated. The City Council may at any time remove a member from office with or without cause and appoint a qualified person to serve out the unexpired term of any member so removed.

(b) Six (6) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. During the first meeting of the Board in October of each year, the members shall elect one of their number to act as chairman.

(c) The City Manager shall designate a person to serve as Secretary of the Board.

Section 3. Duties of the Youth Opportunity Board.

The Youth Opportunity Board shall perform the following duties:

(a) Review, study and sponsor any and all youth activities which they may deem appropriate, including but not limited to recreation, education, culture and cultural programs of every kind and nature.

(b) Make such recommendation to the City Council as it may deem advisable.

Section 4. Meetings and Recommendations.

(a) The Youth Opportunity Board shall meet at the call of the Chairman at least once each month in the City Hall. It shall give at least five (5) days' notice of all meetings by posting such notice on the Bulletin Board at the City Hall. All meetings of the Board shall be open to the public.


(b) Such recommendations as the Board shall from time to time make to the City Council shall be in writing. The Board shall coordinate its activities and plans with the City Zoning Board, the City Board of Adjustment and the City Planning Commission.

Severability. If any word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any other word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance.


