

ORDINANCE NO. 720.2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 720 THE SAME BEING DIVISION 6 OF ARTICLE X OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI SO AS TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE YOUTH OPPORTUNITY BOARD TO SEVENTEEN MEMBERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI HEREBY ORDAINS:

That Ordinance No. 720, the same being Division 6 of Article X of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of North Miami be and the same is hereby amended so that Subsections 2-133(a) and 2-134(a) shall read as follows:

Section 2-133. Establishment of Youth Opportunity Board; Composition and Qualifications.

- (a) There is hereby created and established the youth opportunity board consisting of seventeen (17) members who shall be appointed by the city council and shall hold office at the pleasure of the city council.

\* \* \*

Section 2-134. Term of office, quorum, officers, removal.

- (a) The city council shall appoint seventeen (17) members of the youth opportunity board to hold office until the second Tuesday in June of the odd numbered year next following their appointment. Appointments thereafter shall be until the second Tuesday in June of successive odd numbered years. In every instance members shall hold office until a successor is duly appointed and all terms of office shall begin and end at noon on the date indicated. The city council may at any time remove a member from office with or without cause and appoint a qualified person to serve out the unexpired term of any member so removed.

Severability. If any word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any other word, clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance.

Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but only insofar as such ordinances may be inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.
