Throughout the world, everyone has experienced many changes in their daily lives due to COVID-19. As a City, we too had our fair share of changes; but we will continue to adjust, adapt and follow the recommendations of federal, state and local authorities to gradually re-open our City in a measure that safeguards us all.

The city of North Miami continues to operate under a state of emergency, declared on March 13, 2020, due to coronavirus global pandemic. Today, I signed another emergency order which authorizes the reopening of additional business establishments in the City. Effective Monday, June 8, 2020, at 12:01 a.m., banquet halls, gyms, fitness centers, summer camps, youth activities, massage studios or parlors, and tattoo parlors within the City will be permitted to reopen with stringent restrictions in place. This order adheres to Miami-Dade County's latest [executive order](#) and detailed [handbook](#).

As always, the city of North Miami continues to monitor all COVID-19 related Executive Orders issued by Miami-Dade County. We will continue to work diligently to keep the community up-to-date concerning each phase of our reopening process.
